- a)** Calculate his gross income for a regular 40-hour week.

 - b)** Determine Mo's overtime pay rate per hour.

 - c)** Calculate his earnings for the extra shift on Saturday.

 - d)** Determine his total earnings for that week.

 - e)** Mo is paid bi-weekly. Calculate his gross income for the 2-week period that includes the Saturday that he worked.
